

‘Morning Serenade’ Nine Patch Topper van 5` inch Squares



Uitleg Layout verschillende prints met letters

(zie engelse gebruiksaanwijzing)

- Stof A = Panelstof
- Stof B = 5` inch charmpack squares (zie foto voor kleurkeuzes)
- Stof C = van effenblauwe stof (of geel/blauwe bloemenstof in pakket)
- Stof D = 50 cm (effen beige volgens voorbeeld -yellow dots in pakket)
- Stof E = Randstof

**Benodigdheden - Kleedje zonder randstof (45 x 45 inch) -64 euro stof
(Quiltpakket zonder achterkantstof)**

- Panel Morning Serenade
- 1 Charmpack Morning Serenade
- Yellow Blue Florals - 39866-454 – 75 cm x 110cm
- Yellow Dots 98754-555 – 50cm x 110cm
- Achterkant stof (120 x 120 cm) of in tweedelen 2,5 mtr x 110cm met naad naar keuze.

Te snijden delen -versie zonder randstof:

Stof A:Fussy cut panels: 11,5 x 16,5 inch x 4

Stof B: het Charmpack in verschillende prints

Stof C: extra 5 inch squares -12 stuks

Stof C: 2,5 inch x 42 inch – 5 stuks -binding

Stof D : 2 inch x 20 inch stroken – 8 stuks

Stof D :1,75 inch x 12 inch stroken – 8 stuks

Benodigdheden - Kleedje mét extra sashing en randstof (57 x 57 inch)

Quiltpakket 105 euro stof excl achterkantstof

- Panel Morning Serenade
- 1 Charmpack Morning Serenade
- Yellow Blue Florals - 39866-454 – 100 cm x 110cm
- Yellow Dots 98754-555 – 50cm x 110cm
- Randstof Morning Serenade 160 cm x 110 cm
- Achterkant stof (145cm x 145 cm) of in tweedelen 3 mtr x 110cm met naad (naar keuze)

Te snijden delen -versie met extra sashing en randstof: 1,5 inch

Stof A:Fussy cut panels: 11,5 x 16,5 inch x 4

Stof B: het Charmpack in verschillende prints

Stof C: extra 5 inch squares -12 stuks

Stof C : 1,5 inch x 42 inch stroken voor smalle sashing -5 stuks

Stof C: 2,5 inch x 42 inch – 7 stuks binding

Stof D : 2 inch x 20 inch stroken – 8 stuks

Stof D :1,75 inch x 12 inch stoken – 8 stuks

Stof E : Randstof -5,5 inch x 62 inch -4 stuks

Werkwijze voor beide varianten:

Naai volgens de Layouts de blokken – Blok 1, 2 en 3 (kijk naar foto voor kleurkeuzes voor 5 inch delen)

Zet deze aan elkaar volgens de Layout zodat er een 9 patch ontstaat (45 inch)

Voor versie 1 (zonder randstof en extra sashing) wafel het geheel en Quilt door, en zet de binding aan.

Extra voor versie B met randstof:

Zet na het naaien van het midden gedeelte een dunne sashing van 1,5 inch aan bovenstaande top.

Als laatste, de randstof met diagonaal gemaakte hoeken.

Quilt door en zet de binding aan.

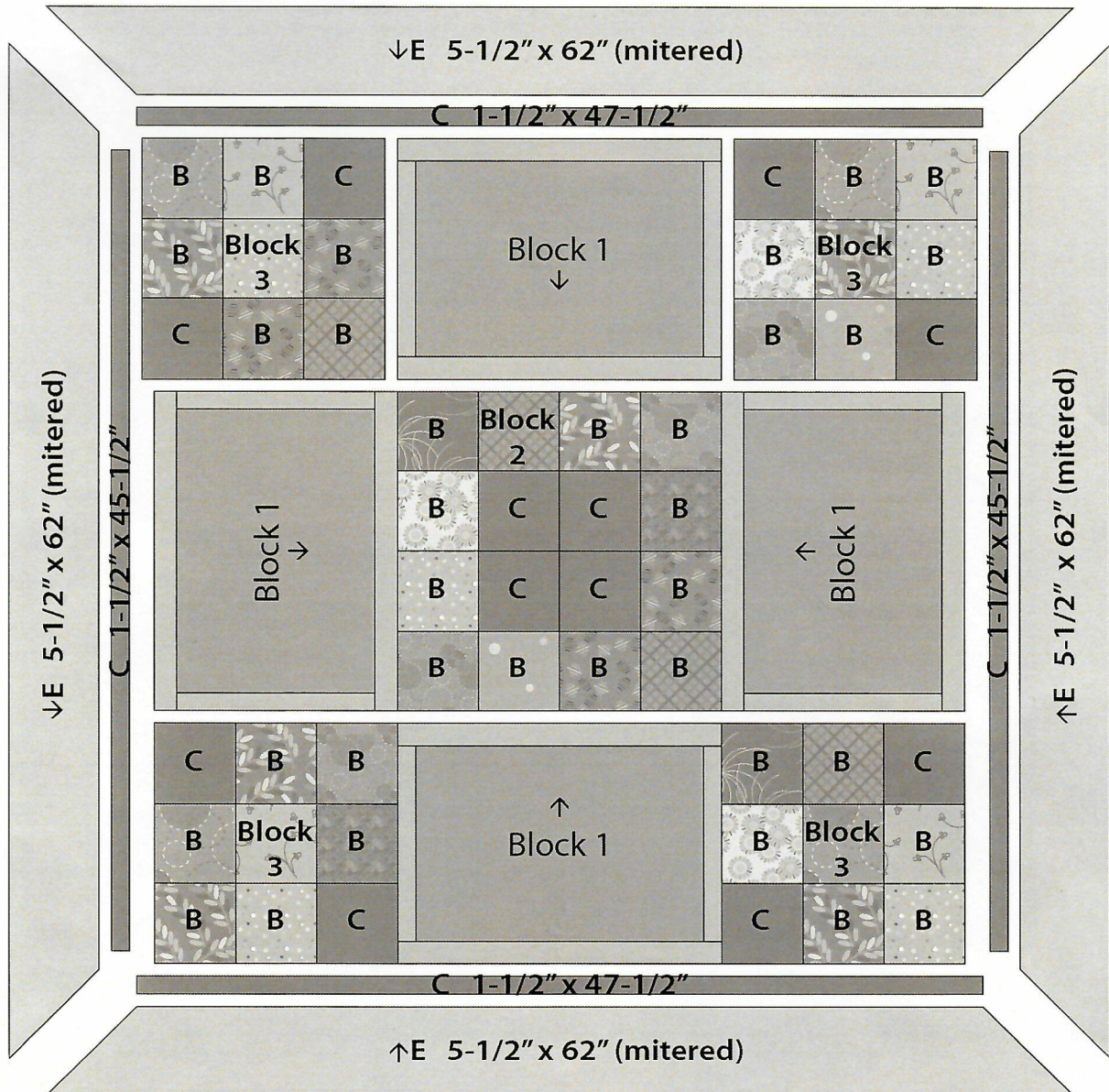

Nine-Patch Topper - Version 1

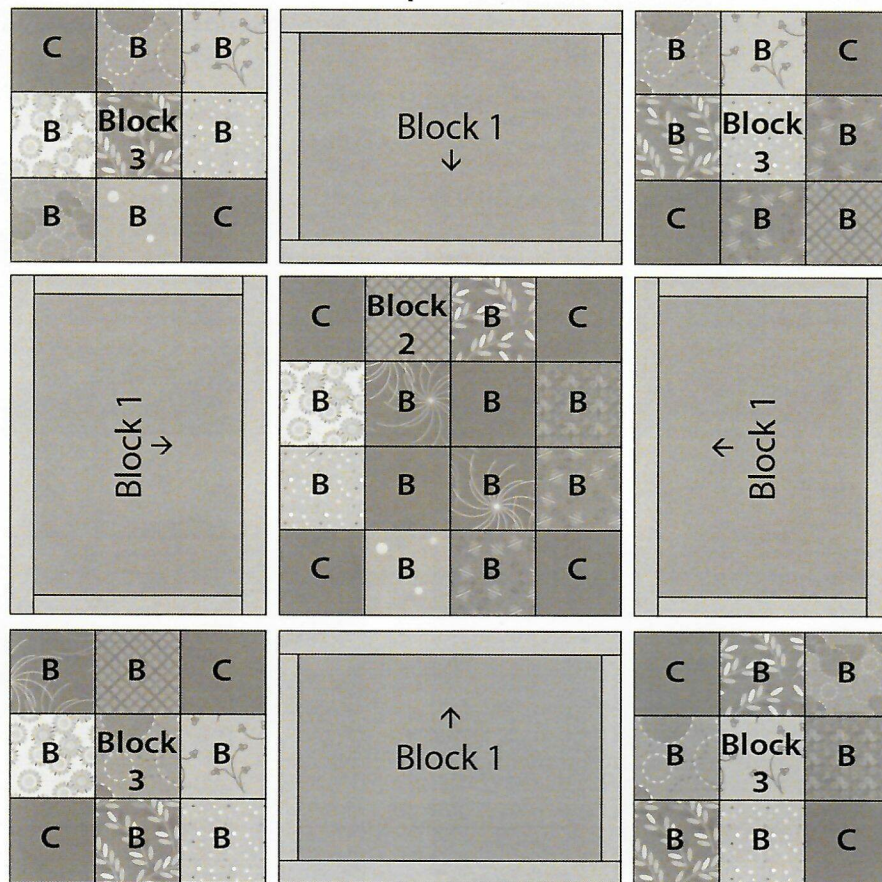

Nine-Patch Topper - Version 2

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" x 16-1/2"

Fabric C - Cut (2) 5" strips, subcut (12) 5" squares

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 47-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 45-1/2" borders

Fabric D - Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (8) 2" x 20" strips

Cut (3) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-3/4" x 12" strips

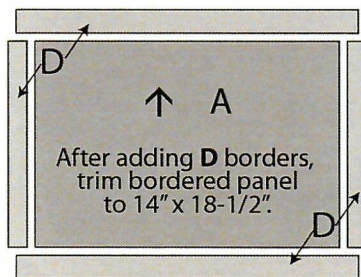
Borders:

Fabric E - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 5-1/2" x 62" multi-stripe borders.

NOTE: Quilt Layout shows just 1 option of how to place the **Fabrics B** and **C** 5" squares. Have fun exploring other options.

2. Piecing Order:

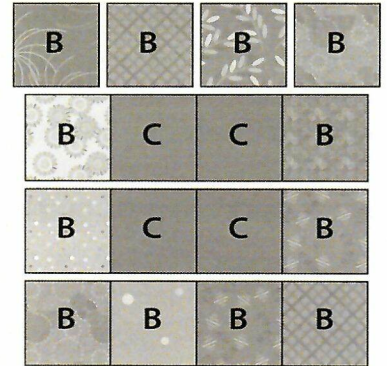
1. Stitch **Fabric D** 1-3/4" x 12" strips to sides of a **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2" x 20" **Fabric D** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 14" x 18-1/2" (unfinished).* Make a total of 4 **Block 1**.



Block 1 - Make 4

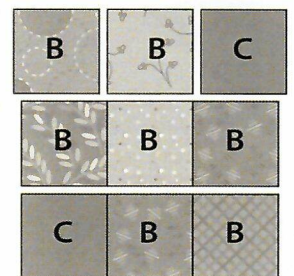
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Arrange a total of 16 **Fabrics B** and **C** 5" squares in 4 rows of 4 squares in a pleasing manner. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 2** (18-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 2 - Make 1

3. Arrange a total of 9 **Fabrics B** and **C** 5" squares in 3 rows of 3 squares in a pleasing manner. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 3** (14" square unfinished).



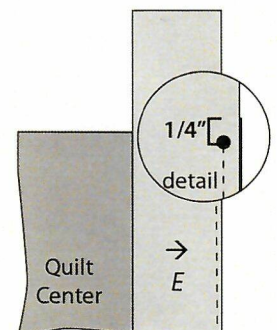
Block 3 - Make 4

4. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

5. Arrange blocks in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Quilt center measures 45-1/2" square (unfinished).

6. Sew **Fabric C** 1-1/2" x 45-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric C** 1-1/2" x 47-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

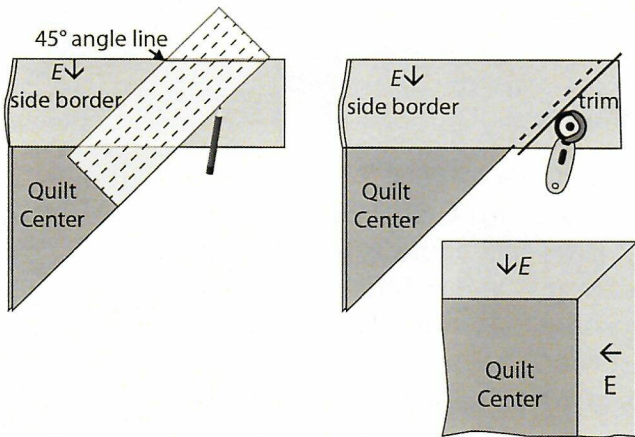
7. Center **Fabric E** 5-1/2" x 62" borders on all sides of quilt center, referring to quilt image for positioning of stripe. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

Nine-Patch Topper - Version 2

8. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



9. The quilt measures approximately 57-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric F**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

10. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric C**) and enjoy!!
